## Board Chosen

### For County

Seven persons were named Wednesday to the newly - created Hamilton County Board of Mental Retardation.

Hamilton County commissioners named five of the members and Probate Court Judge Chase M. Davies appointed the two others.

Named by the board to four-year terms were Robert W. Franks, 8795 Empire Ct., first vice president and chairman of the planning committee of the Hamilton County Council for Retarded Children; Rev. Edward Connelly, 423 Commercial Sq., chaplain of the Catholic Federation for Retarded Children, and Dr. John W. Schreve, 3523 Skyview Ln., associate superintendent of Cincinnati Public Schools and member of the board of trustees of the Community Health and Welfare Council.

Appointed by the board to two-year terms were Mrs. William E. White, 3116 Ferguson Rd., housewife and member of the Hamilton County Diagnostic Clinic for the Mentally Retarded, and E. Roger Jackson, 8086 Merrymaker Ln., assistant director of research for the Heekin Can Co.

Named by Judge Davies to three-year terms were Stuart Warshauer, 8780 Fontainbleau Ter., chairman of the board of trustees of the Resident Home for the Mentally Retarded of Hamilton County, and Eugene L. (Pete) Geier, 33 Weebetook Ln., president of the Security-Amirkhanian Rug & Upholstered Furniture Cleaning Co.

The new board, created by the last General Assembly, will take over immediately the mental retardation duties previously performed by the Child Welfare Board.
